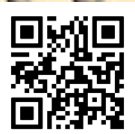

How to come:

> From Bordeaux-Mérignac airport:



By taxi: the journey is around 16 kilometers and takes about 30-40 minutes, depending on the traffic.



By tram: Tram A (direction Floirac), change at "Hôtel de Ville", take Tram B (direction Berges de la Garonne), stop at "Cité du Vin ».

Then, keep walking on rue Lucien Faure for 700 m to reach the hotel.
The total journey takes about 1h40 minutes.

By taxi: the journey takes about 20-25 minutes.



By tram: Tram C (direction Blanquefort), stop at "Quinconces" and take Tram B (direction Berges de la Garonne), stop at "Cité du Vin ».
Then, keep walking on rue Lucien Faure for 700 meters to reach the hotel.
The total journey takes around 40 minutes.
